This past year has been unlike any other in our years of ministry, so we thought it would be interesting to list some facts about what this year has looked like!

27-number of overnight guests we've had in our home this year

7- number of nationalities represented by those guests

40+- number of Ukraine/ Hungary border crossings Dan has made this year with OMS and Hungarian CHOG partners

36,000- number of kilograms (40 tons) of supplies and aid delivered via the Hungarian CHOG van (*approximate*)

3-number of months we filled in as youth leaders for the Hungarian CHOG youth group

58-number of delegates attending 3WLN from 11 different countries in Europe and the Middle East

When our team started 3WLN in 2015 with seed money from the Change the World grant, we dreamed of helping young and emerging leaders in EME connect and learn from each other.
